- How to use simple compass directions.

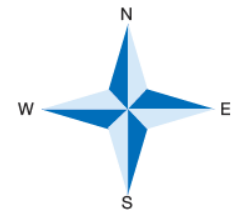
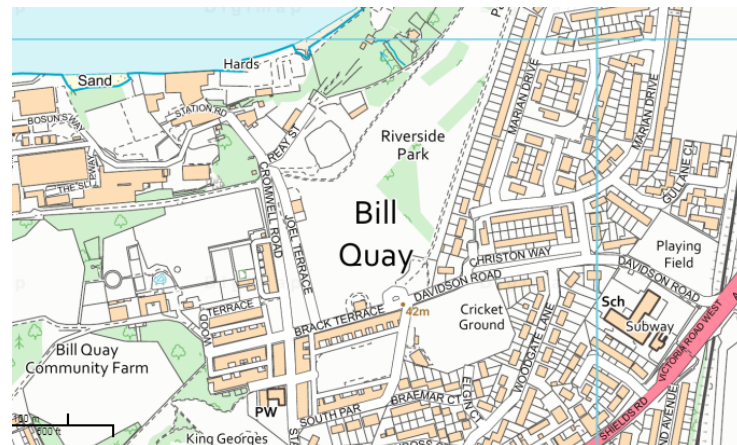
Vocabulary

Compass Point	One of the points on a compass that shows direction.
Grid References	A location on a map identified by letters and numbers.
Human Features	Features such as houses and roads that are built by people.
Key	Information given on a map to help explain symbols.
Map	A diagram of land or an area as seen from above.
Physical Features	Features which are natural such as woods, fields and rivers.
Rural	Relating to the countryside, away from the city or town.
Urban	Towns or cities.

By the end of this unit, I will:

- Use four figure compass points.
- Use 4-figure grid references
- Describe how land is used in our locality and how it has changed over time.
- Identify some standardised symbols on maps.
- Make sketches of what I see.
