**Vocabulary**

Lake	A body of water surrounded by land.
Mountain	A landform that rises high above its surroundings.
Mouth	The place where a river flows into another bigger river, lake, sea or ocean.
Peak	The top of a hill, mountain or mountain range.
Public	People
River	A moving body of water that flows from its source on high ground and into another river, a lake or sea.
Source	The place where a river begins.
Tourism	The business of encouraging and supporting tourists.
Tourist	A person who is visiting a place for pleasure.
Tributary	A river or stream that flows into a bigger river or lake.
Weir	A low dam built across a river to raise the level of water upstream.
Woodland	A type of habitat with lots of trees.
