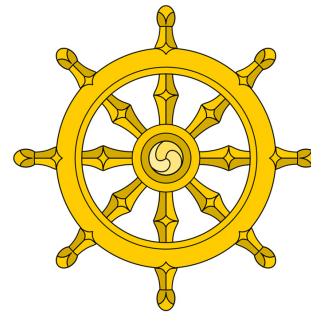

What is the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians today?

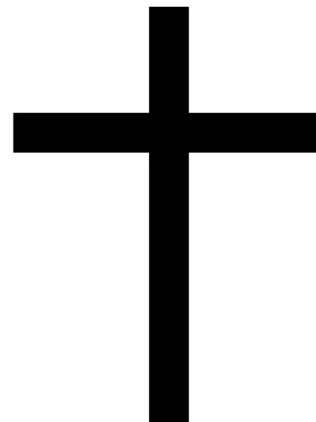

Do people need to go to places of worship to show dedication to their own religion?

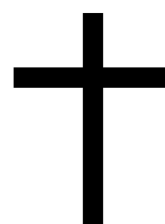
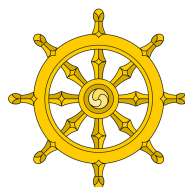
