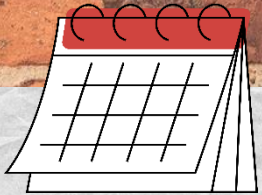




# Summer Term Year 5

## English

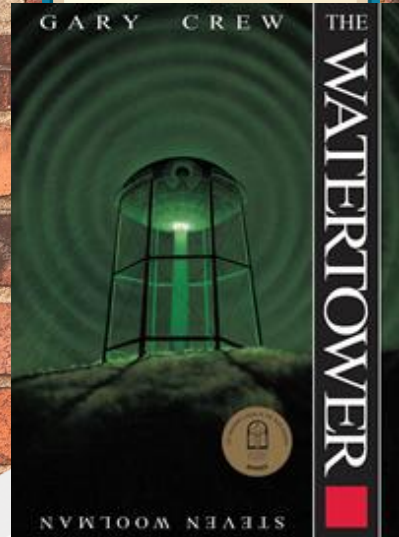
We will be looking at a range of different genres including None-sense poetry, recount writing and finally, narrative writing using The Water Tower book. In SPAG we will be looking at various sentences constructions including complex sentences. We will be investigating how we organise our stories into paragraphs and use features which are appropriate to the genre we are writing. Spelling rules using Spell Shed will continue.

This term, we will be investigating How drugs common to everyday life affect health? and what jobs we would like in the future.

## Maths

We will be covering various areas of mathematical study. We will investigate percentages and decimals. This will include numbers into their tenths, hundredths and thousandths. We will then look at the connections between fractions, decimals and percentages and how to move between each form. We will complete blocks on co-ordinates, properties of shapes and decimals. We will also look at the conversion of measurements and how to do this effectively. Throughout the term we will develop and consolidate our times tables and mental arithmetic knowledge.

## History / Geography

This term, we will complete our studies of ancient civilisations and how they lived. We will also be investigating Rivers and Coasts looking at how the course of a river can change on its journey to the sea and how the coastline can change through erosion and human use of the land.

## Science

During our science sessions we class will explore the processes reproduction in plants, find out about sexual reproduction in animals, investigate the differences in the life cycles of different animals.

We will learn about sexual reproduction and gestation, how young children grow and develop, the changes that occur during puberty as well as discovering about the changing needs of humans during old age.

**PE**  
This term we will be continuing to swim and will work with NUFC on Commander Joes. Also focusing on improving our skills in gymnastics and handball.

## Music / MFL

We will also be learning about music from different parts of the UK including singing folk songs and musical vocabulary and Fun with scales.

In French we will be looking at conversational aspects of ordering food and dealing with different modes of transport. To translate sentences or short texts from French to English and English to French including the use of a dictionary or supporting resource. We will listen and apply knowledge of phonemes to help understand extended sentences.

## Art

Using inspiration of historical monuments and modern installations, children will plan by researching and drawing a sculpture to fit a design brief. They will investigate scale, the display environment and possibilities for viewer interaction with their piece.

## Computing

During our computing time we will be looking at how to use different drawing tools to help them create images. Learn how to write programs that ask questions and use selection to control the outcomes based on the answers given

## RE

We will be investigating the questions – How can believers and non-believers co-exist? Exploring the common ground between religious and non-religious people. Also, What is the best way for a Christian to show commitment to God? We will focus on the key skills of building our understanding of these issues.

## Design and Technology

Explore how gears and pulleys can transfer force and motion within mechanical systems. It explains how gears change speed, direction, and force, using clear visuals and terminology such as “input” and “output” to describe mechanisms like those in bicycles.
